

Contest Rules

Courtside View for Two – Finals

1. Contest Organizer

The contest is held and organized by Beneva Inc. (“Beneva” or the “Contest Organizer”).

2. Contest Period

The contest takes place in Quebec in two distinct phases:

- *Courtside View for Two – Finals* contest, at the Beneva activation zone during the National Bank Open (see section 4.1): from August 1, 2026, at midnight to August 11, 2026, at 10:00 p.m. (ET) (the “Contest Period”).
- *Courtside View for Two – Tennis Giant* contest, at the Beneva activation zone during the National Bank Open (see section 4.2): from August 12, 2026, at midnight to August 11, 2026, at 10:00 p.m. (ET) (the “Contest Period”).

3. Eligibility conditions

To enter this contest, participants must:

- **Be a resident of the province of Quebec**
- **Be age 18 or over on or before July 19, 2026**

4. How do you enter?

Participation in this contest is free, with no purchase necessary.

To enter the contest, participants must satisfy the eligibility conditions and the other conditions set out in these contest rules.

Subject to the limitations stated in these rules, there are two ways to enter during the Contest Period:

4.1 *Courtside View for Two – Finals* – On site, in the Beneva activation zone

To enter, participants must:

4.2 **Courtside View for Two – Tennis Giant contest: On site, in the Beneva activation zone**

To enter, participants must:

- Fill out the electronic entry form with a Beneva ambassador in the Beneva zone at the 2026 National Bank Open in Montreal and participate in the on-site game. Registration page: <https://beneva.ca/en/contest/courtside-view-finals>
- **Limit: Unlimited entries per person per day**

5. Prize details

Entering this contest gives you the chance to win one of the following prizes:

5.1 **Courtside View for Two – Finals contest**

On site, in the Beneva activation zone. Five (5) winners will each receive a pair of tickets to the Beneva Balcony for the final session on August 13 at 5:30 p.m.

Winners must be available on Thursday, August 13, at 5:30 p.m. and will each be awarded one pair of tickets for the final session on August 13 at 5:30 p.m.

The approximate total value of the prize is \$600 for a pair of tickets or \$300 for a single ticket.

5.2 **Courtside View for Two – Tennis Giant contest:**

On site, in the Beneva activation zone. Two (2) winners of a \$200 Tennis Giant gift card.

The approximate retail value of the prize is \$200 for a Tennis Giant gift card.

6. Specific prize conditions

The prize is non-cashable and cannot be transferred, assigned or exchanged.

Beneva is not responsible if a session is cancelled or postponed by Tennis Canada. In the event of cancellation or postponement, the session may not be rescheduled.

7. Draw

7.1 **Date and location**

The prize will be awarded by a random draw from the eligible entries.

- The draw (*Courtside View for Two – Tennis Giant*) will take place on August 14, 2026 at 9:30 a.m. in front of a witness among Beneva employees, at its offices located at 2525 boul. Laurier, Quebec QC G1V 2L2.

7.2 Odds of winning

The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received during the Contest Period.

7.3 Disqualification or cancellation

Beneva reserves the right to disqualify persons or cancel entries that are not in compliance with these contest rules.

8. Participation limitations and exclusions

8.1 Number of entries

The number of entries per person is limited in accordance with the provisions under section 4 of these Contest rules.

8.2 Participant exclusion

Employees, mandataries, officers, administrators and representatives of Beneva Inc. and its affiliated companies, and individuals residing at the same address, may not enter the contest.

Also excluded from entering the contest are representatives, agents, firms and agencies attached or affiliated with Beneva Inc. and its affiliated companies as well as their employees and any persons residing with them.

9. General conditions

- Correctly answer, without assistance and within a limited time, a mathematical skill-testing question.
- Sign a liability waiver and declaration form, which will be forwarded by the Organizer. This form must be returned to Beneva on August 13 before 12:00 p.m. Please email the form to concours@beneva.ca.

Failure to comply with any of the above conditions or to accept the prize will result in disqualification of the selected participant and the Organizer will have the right to cancel the prize.

Courtside View for Two – Tennis Giant contest:

- Reply to the email sent by the Organizer to be informed of the terms and conditions for awarding their prize on August 20, at 10:00 a.m., failing which the prize will be forfeited by the participant.

The Organizer will send two reminders:

- one by email on August 17, 2026

- a telephone call on August 19, 2026

- Confirm that they meet the eligibility conditions and other requirements of these contest rules.
- Correctly answer, without assistance and within a limited time, a mathematical skill-testing question.
- Sign a liability waiver and declaration form, which will be forwarded by the Organizer. This form must be returned to Beneva within three (3) days following receipt. The form must be returned by email to: concours@beneva.ca.

Failure to comply with any of the above conditions or to accept the prize will result in disqualification of the selected participant and the Organizer will have the right to cancel the prize.

9.1 Verification

Entries are subject to verification by the Organizer. Any entry or entry attempt that is deemed to be fraudulent, illegible, incomplete, received late or otherwise not in compliance with contest rules will be rejected. In such a case, the participant in question will not be entitled to an entry or a prize. The Organizer's decision concerning any aspect of the contest, including but not limited to the eligibility or disqualification of entries, will be final and without appeal.

9.2 Disqualification

The Organizer reserves the right to disqualify any person or cancel one or more entries from a person who enters this contest or tries to do so by any means contrary to these contest rules or which would be unfair to the other entrants. Such person may be referred to the appropriate judicial authorities. The Organizer's decision regarding this aspect of the contest is final and without appeal.

The prizes must be accepted as described in these contest rules. They are not, in any case, transferable in whole or in part to another person, unless otherwise indicated, if applicable.

The National Bank Open session schedule is not subject to change and is determined by Tennis Canada.

9.4 Limitation of liability – Use of the prize

The prize winner releases the Organizer, its advertising and promotional agencies and their employees, agents and representatives from any potential damage, harm or loss resulting from their acceptance or use of the prize.

All participants selected acknowledge that, as of their being informed of the prize delivery arrangements, the fulfilment of the obligations related to the prize becomes the entire and exclusive responsibility of the various service and product providers.

9.5 Limitation of liability – Contest operation

The Organizer, its advertising and promotional agencies, its affiliated companies, their employees, agents and representatives are not liable for any technological malfunctions that limit or make it impossible to enter the contest.

This includes any faulty computer components, software or lines of communication, the loss or absence of network communication capability, or any faulty, incomplete, incomprehensible or deleted transmissions by any computer or network.

9.6 Limitation of liability – Registration

The Organizer and its affiliated companies may be doing business with one or more service provider(s) based outside of Quebec. It is therefore possible that some of your personal information held by the Organizer may be stored outside of Quebec and governed by the laws of foreign countries or states. By completing contest forms, participants tacitly accept such a situation.
